

Stakes & Canes

Bamboo stakes are flexible and robust, making them suitable for a wide range of indoor and outdoor applications. They are versatile and have many uses.



Sawn or split cranks can be used for many purposes, and are available in different sizes and species of wood. It is important to note the origin of the wood, whether it is French or from another country.



Beech wood is a hard wood with a light yellow to pink colour and a homogeneous appearance. It is easily recognised by the pattern of the many small woody rays. Its durability is approximately 5 years and it originates from France.



Ash is a hard wood commonly used for handles of shovels, axes, picks, and bows due to its flexibility and resistance to vibration. It originates from France.



The wood of chestnut trees is naturally resistant to decay, microbes, and insects due to the high concentration of tannins (6% in the bark and 13% in the wood) which are not easily washed away by rain. The wood is abundant in tannins and has very little sapwood. This makes it an ideal choice for outdoor structural timber as it does not require any chemical treatments. It can be sourced from French or other origins.



Oaks are hardwood trees with high natural durability due to their tannin content, making them highly resistant to insects and fungi. This particular oak may be of French or other origin.



Landscapes sleepers with different species and sizes, whether treated or untreated.



The wood used is a combination of *Eucalyptus saligna* and *Eucalyptus grandis*, selected for their unique properties. Through autoclave treatment, the wood has a lifespan of approximately 8 to 10 years.



The exo stakes are made from carefully selected species for their physical properties and resistance. They are durable without the need for chemical treatment and are produced sustainably.



Treated pine stakes are an economical alternative for staking young plants and protecting them. They are pointed and suitable for most situations.



Robinia (*Robinia pseudoacacia*) is a durable and resilient wood that can withstand challenging conditions without the need for chemical treatment. It is long-lasting and can be sourced from France or other locations.
